


Review of Master Plan Process

- Master Plans are Long-Term Plans
 - > 10 to 15 year timeframe
 - Living document regularly revisited and revised
- Completed:
 - Facility assessments
 - Demographic analysis
 - Education Specifications
 - Community outreach meetings
- Master Plans Created for Each Campus
 - Developed by school/community Site Planning groups

Review of Master Plan Process

- Site Planning Groups Refined Categories
 - Critical Facility Needs
 - Educational Program Needs
 - Future Facility Needs
- Obtain User and Community Input
 - 54 individual school master planning meetings
 - Approximately 400 attendees
 - Incorporated input from three Community Outreach meetings
- Cost Estimates Developed for all Campus Master Plans
- Draft Facilities Master Plan Published






Facility Master Plan - Estimated Costs
