Structure of District Leadership Teams

Leadership teams consist of administrators and teachers (members of the ILT) from each site. They meet once a month to plan and execute a shared vision and focus for their students and community.

❖To Date: 37 teachers have taken part in the process.



Core Ideas for 2013-14 ILT

The Moral Imperative: effective instruction for ALL students

- Identify and focus on the Powerful Instructional Practices (PIPs) that support the Common Core Shifts
- Engage as learners in the work we must ourselves lead
- Site-based inquiry into the processes of teaching and learning



Purpose of Common Core Professional Development

- Empower teacher leaders and teachers to provide onsite professional development to their teachers and parents through focused training and application to sites.
- Provide opportunities to collaborate with peers and discuss successful implementation practices.

Powerful Instructional Practices (PIPs) Common Core: Summary

PIPs:

- ✓ Increase learning for students at ALL levels
- ✓ Have a sound theoretical basis
- ✓ Develop transferable academic skills
- ✓ Impact learning beyond the targeted instructional area
- ✓ Can be observed and measured in student learning

Some Examples of the activities:

- Close reading, a PIP that promotes deep learning across all 6 shifts required by the Common Core.
- District-wide reading and professional development using Core 6 Book by H. Silver, J. Penni (Provided to all teachers in the district)



Instructional Rounds: Purpose

- Purpose is to provide information about instructional practices that the school has decided to focus on.
- Provide opportunities for ILT members to have dialogue about school practice and instruction.
- Planning time for ILT members from visited schools to share information with entire school.
- Discussion time for visitors to identify new learnings.
- Conducted Instructional Rounds at 4 schools: Lum, Wood, Ruby Bridges and Island.

Instructional Rounds: Summary In Action at AUSD

Schools	Date	# of ILT Participants	# of Classrooms Observed
Lum Elementary School	2-18-14	31	6
Wood Middle School	2-18-14	23	6
Ruby Bridges Elementary School	4-22-14	28	9
Island High School	4-22-14	27	8

Fullan Leadership: Purpose
